

Celebrating Our Graduates





In this regard, and appreciating the opportunities that adversity presents, allows me to highlight some of the areas we focused on in the last academic year and hopefully wish to consolidate in the coming academic year.

Strategic Partnerships & Global Academic Expansion

1. Global Maritime Leadership

Our university strengthened its leadership in maritime education through partnerships with:

- ◆ Korea Maritime and Ocean University.
- ◆ Korea Institute of Maritime and Fisheries Technology (KIMFT).
- ◆ Kenya Maritime Authority.
- ◆ State Department for Shipping & Maritime.
- ◆ Royal Danish Embassy.

Sir, these collaborations are preparing a new generation of maritime engineers, nautical scientists, and global seafarers - young people ready to propel Kenya's blue economy to the world as evidenced by our graduands from the Fisheries and Maritime Institute. It is instructive to note that we continue to be at the center of maritime conversation within and without the Country-a position we shall consolidate in the coming year and beyond



2. Global Scholarships & Academic Mobility

3. A Transformational Partnership: PIU & University of Nebraska–Lincoln (UNL)

Mr. Chancellor, ladies and gentlemen, our partnership with the University of Nebraska–Lincoln (UNL) marks one of the most visionary developments in our recent history.

UNL is a global leader in agriculture, natural resources, water management, and agri-technology. Together, PIU and UNL are laying the foundation for one of the strongest Schools of Agriculture and Natural Resources in Africa.

Under your leadership- Chancellor and the Secretary of State of Nebraska, a historic initiative is underway to twin the State of Nebraska with Murang’a County - replicating the powerful model UNL uses with Nebraska and adapting it for Kenya. Sir, we look forward to working with you now that the State of Nebraska bestowed on you the Honorary Citizenship of that state due to your commitment to human promotion and transformation by bridging continents- Congratulations

Competency-Based Education (CBE) Leadership

Mr. Chancellor Sir, Pioneer International University was the first university in Kenya to align the Bachelor of Education (Arts) to the Competency-Based Education (CBE) framework. This revised program was rigorously reviewed and

officially approved by the Commission for University Education (CUE).

Our CBE-aligned program emphasizes:

- ▶ mastery of content and pedagogy.
- ▶ learner-centered teaching.
- ▶ creativity in instructional design.
- ▶ digital integration.
- ▶ critical thinking and problem-solving.
- ▶ practical teaching competence.

Sir, I wish to confidently report that, today, PIU-trained teachers are some of the most sought-after in the country.

In the coming few days, a senate standing committee shall be in place to ensure, in collaboration with the Commission for University Education (CUE) that all the regulations and guidelines put in place to transition all the other programs to CBE are adhered to as we prepare to receive the first CBE freshmen in 2029. This journey has not, and will not be easy as it requires a lot of retooling our faculty and investment in our teaching, learning and research infrastructure to support all the envisaged pathways.

Mr. Chancellor, I wish to assure you that, working together with the new Governing Council, we shall support and deliver on all aspects of the higher education reforms that relate to university education as guided by the Ministry of Education and the regulator as we position our University as the next academic frontier in CBE. In this journey I’m reminded of some African proverbs:

“Smooth seas do not make skillful sailors.”

- African Proverb

“Difficult roads often lead to beautiful destinations.”

Industrial Attachment: A University-Wide Philosophy

School of Divinity.

Mr. Chancellor Sir, in the last academic year, the Senate approved the establishment of this school to offer rigorous academic programs in divinity, theology and religious studies. Sir, the flagship program has been the Post-

Graduate Diploma in Transformational Church Administration and Leadership (PGD-TCAL) This program is centered on leadership development equipping and retooling the clergy to serve and lead the modern church.

Sir, working together with the Church, we have rolled out the program across Kenya, and we expect the first graduates in that school next year. We continue to appreciate your inspiration and support particularly in reaching out to the Church leadership across ecu-



menical spectrum in the country and persuading them to send their clergy to join this program in the coming year.

School of Health & Allied Sciences (From Next Year)

In response to Kenya's need for health professionals, next year, we will launch two new programs:

- ◆ Bachelor of Pharmacy
- ◆ Bachelor of Health Information Technology & Management

We look forward in the next 3-4 years to launch the - Bachelor of Biomedical Engineering and Bachelor of Public Health

Mr. Chancellor Sir, the school will help bridge the gap in healthcare workforce shortages in areas like pharmacy, health information management and biological engineering. By focusing on public health, the school can contribute to preventing diseases, promoting health, and improving healthcare outcomes in the community.

We look forward to the school engaging with local communities through outreach programs, health fairs and other initiatives, promoting health awareness and education.

Looking Ahead

As we step into the new year, our upcoming Strategic Plan will focus on strengthening research, launching new programs that are market driven including postgraduate programs, expanding partnerships, and enhancing our student experience. We look forward to a better year ahead even as we invite those graduating from the high School to join our Transitional to University Program(TUP)-a ten week program starting from January 5th,2026 that seeks to meaningfully engage students during the long post-examination period and prepare their minds for academic freedom, moral responsibility, and independent life of the university environment.

School of Health and Allied Sciences

The SOHAS is envisioned to be a Centre for Enablement (C4E) in health and allied sciences education, training, research, and innovation. A Center for Enablement in health sciences education and training provides resources and guidance to empower health professionals and educators to build skills and adopt innovative practices. This vision is anchored on values of integrity, excellence, innovation, collaboration, and social responsibility. SOHAS will develop graduates who are not only technically proficient and creative problem-solvers but also ethically grounded and socially responsible citizens capable of addressing Kenya's health challenges and contributing to global health. We will contribute to increasing the quantity, quality and relevance of health professionals in order to meet population health needs and expectations.

As a new school, we will initially establish four programmes with proposed student admissions in 2026/2027. These programmes are Bachelor of Pharmacy; Bachelor of Science in Health Information Technology and Management; Bachelor of Science in Public Health; and Bachelor of Science in Biomedical Engineering. This choice of programmes is briefly rationalized below.

Kenya's pharmaceutical manufacturing sector has been growing, but there is a persistent shortage of personnel with specialized training in industrial pharmaceuticals. It has been observed that current educational offerings are often not fully aligned with the technical and practical needs of the manufacturing industry, creating a skills gap. SOHAS proposes a tailored programme that will lay special emphasis on training Pharmacists to respond to the govern-



ment policy of local manufacturing.

Due to advances and innovations taking place globally in healthcare and in the field of information technology, increasing adoption of digital health systems by hospitals, research institutions, medical education institutions, and health insurance organizations; highly qualified personnel in the field of Health Information Technology and Management are continuously in demand. The recently enacted Digital Health Act, 2023, which represents a significant advancement in the digital transformation of healthcare services in Kenya further creates requirements for new training methods and practices that safeguard health information.

BSc in Public Health prepares students to improve population health by preventing disease, protecting and promoting the health and well-being of communities. It provides an interdisciplinary foundation in areas like epidemiology, social and environmental health, and health informatics, and offers career

paths in fields ranging from health education to health administration and research.

Biomedical Engineering combines the design and problem-solving skills of engineering with medical and biological sciences to improve healthcare through the design, manufacturing, installation and maintenance of medical equipment and devices. As Kenya's overall specialised health care offerings increase, there is a concurrent increase in quantity and sophistication of medical equipment and devices. The country has a shortage of Biomedical Engineers. They are required for the installation, operation, and maintenance of advanced medical equipment and devices in hospitals and other healthcare settings.

Curriculum design will focus on interdisciplinary approaches that challenge students to apply knowledge from various fields to solve real-world problems, fostering critical thinking and collaboration. Our programmes will pursue aligning technology with human values, reflecting on the ethical and societal implications of new technologies and innovations. A pioneering future is one where technology serves humanity, not the other way around.

SOHAS as a Centre for Enablement (C4E) in health and allied sciences education and training will foster an ecosystem of shared, standardized, and accessible learning resources and practices. We will promote competency-based education ensuring our graduates possess the appropriate knowledge, skills and behaviours required for practice in healthcare settings and industry.
